Location: Scotland Neck, North Carolina

Date: Friday, October 13, 2017 7:00am- 4:00pm | Cost \$75 per person | AIRFARE & OVERNIGHT LODGING IN RALEIGH NC ARE NOT INCLUDED. ATTENDEE MUST PURCHASE FLIGHT AND BOOK HOTEL ROOM. DETAILS BELOW.

Goal of tour: Join Better Cotton Initiative (BCI) for a chance to visit a U.S. cotton farm and gin, learn about local cotton production issues, and implementation of the Better Cotton Standard in the USA.

Agenda

Attendees are responsible for departing the Bolger Center and getting to Raleigh-Durham International Airport (RDU) on their own. **Attendee must arrive on Thursday Oct. 12* in order to depart at 7:00am on Oct. 13** at Embassy Suites Brier Creek, near RDU airport. BCI will provide transportation from hotel, throughout the day and ending at RDU Airport. It is highly recommended to book post-tour departure flight from RDU no earlier than 6:00pm Friday evening.

- **7:00am:** Bus departs Embassy Suites Brier Creek 8001 Arco Corporate Drive. Check-out and bring luggage on the bus if you intend to be dropped at RDU upon return.
 - Learn about cotton growing and BCI basics en route.
- 9:00am: Bus arrives at Scotland Neck, NC area cotton farm.
- **9:00am 10:30am:** Tour cotton farm, see harvest underway, learn about modern production & environmental protection methods.
- 10:30am 12:00pm: At Edwards Gin, see cotton lint separated from seed, cleaned and baled.
- 12:00pm 1:00pm: Enjoy a North Carolina style barbeque, hosted by Allenberg Cotton.
- 1:30pm: Bus departs gin.
- **3:30pm:** Bus arrives back to Raleigh-Durham International Airport, then to Embassy Suites Brier Creek.

This agenda is subject to change. Registered tour attendees will receive updates as they occur. Arrival and departure times will not change.
