Description

Better Cotton is the world's largest cotton sustainability programme. Our mission: to help cotton communities survive and thrive, while protecting and restoring the environment. In difficult times, we are meeting the challenge head on. Through our network of field-level partners we have provided training on more sustainable farming practices to more than 2.9 million cotton farmers in 26 countries. More than a fifth of the world's cotton is now grown under the Better Cotton Standard and our membership network includes more than 2,400 members.

Background

We are seeking proposals from skilled individuals or agencies interested in designing a short video for the launch of the newest version of the Better Cotton farm-level standard – the Principles & Criteria.

This is a core document for Better Cotton, as it sets out the global definition of Better Cotton. By following the principles and criteria that are outlined in the document, Better Cotton Farmers produce cotton in a way that is better for themselves, their communities and the environment.

In October 2021, we launched the revision of the Better Cotton Principles & Criteria. The aim of the revision was to strengthen the Principles & Criteria to ensure they continue to meet best practice, are effective and locally relevant, and align with Better Cotton's 2030 strategy.

The revision is now complete, and we would like to accompany the launch of the new standard with a video that can explain in a visually appealing way the new requirements and focus areas, together with the main changes resulting from the revision process.

Scope of Work

The expected output will be to produce a 60-90 second video using existing footage from the field and 2D animations, on the basis of a draft script and information provided by Better Cotton.

We will provide access to Better Cotton's illustration library, to facilitate the process and ensure alignment with existing communication tools.

The design process should allow for two revision rounds before the final version of the video is supplied.

The designer must also provide Better Cotton with all the illustration assets and original files as a package upon completion.

In addition to skills, competencies and expertise, we will consider value for money and demonstrable commitment to the sustainability field to evaluate applications.
