Background

The request for Certinia Consultancy Services is part of the wider technology strategy of the IT & Data function and sits within the scope of the IT Services Team (IST). IST's mission is to enable Better Cotton staff to succeed in their roles supporting cotton communities, through optimised and secure digital infrastructure.

As such, we are seeking proposals from skilled Certinia partners and/or consultants to provide comprehensive Managed and Development Services for our ERP platform.



The Certinia partner/consultant will fill in the gaps in support and technical know-how within the team to ensure our ERP solution is optimised and aligned with our CRM (Salesforce) and internal processes.

Key Considerations:

- Global Impact: Our work supports our offices in London, Geneva, Pakistan and India
- Operational Functions: accounting, grants/funding, budgeting and forecasting
- Digital Tool Stack: M365, Conga, Form Assembly, DocuSign, Salesforce, Expensify, Stripe, PISA, SEPA. Gearset
- Industry Best Practices: We expect the selected partner to adhere to industry standards and non-profit requirements

Scope of Work

The Scope of work can be defined in two areas:

- 1. Managed Services: to enable self-sufficiency in administering the platform (e.g. training, documentation, strategic advice, etc.) as well as any technical support (e.g. fixing bugs/issues arising from already established processes) as they arise.
- 2. **Development Services:** to deliver ad-hoc project/development work by responding to IST's business requirements and providing a solution that primarily leverages the out of box solutions from Certinia, Salesforce and/or any of our other tools in our stack while also adhering to IST's development processes (BRD acceptance, Solution design, end to end testing, UAT, documentation and training, etc.). Among the projects slated for this year are:
 - a. System mapping and documentation
 - b. Enhancements to the Budget upload tool
 - c. Mapping Dimensions to Accounts Receivables

- Feasibility of the proposed activity plan and timeline, and appropriateness of time allocated to delivering each task.
- Relevant professional experience of the proposed consultant(s).
- Quality and relevance of the proposal.

Financial Evaluation Criteria

- Quality and clarity of budget provided, and level of detail included.
- Alignment of the budget to the activity timeline detailed in the technical proposal.
- Value for money.
- Adherence to the available budget.
